

2019 EDCO League

Now Administered by MN Recreation

This past fall the EDCO League made a few changes to increase player and team participation. The league has been providing competitive baseball without a total summer commitment (16 to 22 games including playoffs) in Delaware County for nearly 75 years. We are very excited about the new look of the league which include the following changes for the 2019 Season:

MN Recreation (Marple Newtown) will administer the league handling team registration, individual registration, and web-site and scheduling along with other administrative functions. MN Recreation offers over 125 programs throughout the year reaching beyond the local community and throughout the county with three full time employees for nearly 50 years. The league as always will accept team registrations, but will also add individuals who will be drafted by the coaches that works geographically for the players and the competitiveness of the league.

Age Change for the Intermediate and Senior Divisions. The Intermediates will now be 19 and under and the seniors will be 18 to 26, but can also maintain **three players update to age 29** if they have played at least 5 years of Senior EDCO baseball. The purpose of this is to increase participation, mentor the younger players and introduce the player coach. Also, players age 17 may also play Senior EDCO if they are going into their senior year of high school and request a waiver.

Teams for the most part are geographically entered and include teams from Briarcliffe, Broomall, Folcroft, Newtown, Brookhaven, Garnet Valley, Highland Park, Marple Newtown, Media, Ridley and Springfield.
