

The meeting to kick off the 2019 Season will be held on Wednesday March 13th 7PM at the MN Recreation Community Center. The recreation center complex is at the corner of West Chester Pike and Media Line Road. Please enter the gym on West Chester Pike, one light west and across from St Anastasia. Someone in the gym will direct you to the meeting room.

PLEASE LET US KNOW IF YOU WILL BE ATTENDING THE MEETING. If you can't make the meeting or send a representative, please let me know if you plan to participate in 2019.

The costs are as follows:

1. Tri-County \$65 one umpire per game home team pays, two umpire's playoffs both teams play (next night playoff extra innings \$10 per inning)
2. Leagues fee will be \$100
3. Umpire Assignor fee \$100

If you prefer to pay at the first meeting, the \$100 league registration fee should be made payable to MN Recreation and the check for the assignor will be made payable to Judy Mills (my office manager). Many leagues are much more expensive and we have done everything we can to lower the costs. We also have done everything we could think of to accommodate player participation but also uphold the integrity of the league.

Each division will be broken down into two divisions, with all teams making the playoffs. Depending the numbers, the lower seeds most likely will have a play in game. The division names are as follows:

Intermediate: Musser and Crossan

Seniors: Gansky and Sculli

The meeting agenda will be sent next Friday and rules for the 2019 season will be distributed at the first meeting. There will be one set of rules for both leagues with changes made to emphasize more regular season games, available playing time with EH, DH, free defensive substitutions 3rd, 4th and 5th innings and all playoff series will be three games. Each team will be permitted to submit one waiver for league approval in regards to a player not within the age parameters.

One reminder, a very important reminder to all that the EDCO League has evolved over nearly 75 years as a very popular stop for summer baseball. It is not high school, college or semi-pro baseball. It is a summer league where many players want to work on their game for their high school or college teams, but just as many players continue to play because of their love of the game.
